

- Photography:** Any person wishing to take photographs **MUST** complete a G.N.A.S. photography registration form & send it to the tournament organiser before the last date of entry.
- Drug testing:** Record status shoots are liable to drug testing, competitors approached to give samples must comply. Refusal to comply will be treated as a positive result for an illegal substance. Archers must sign the entry form to signify their consent.
- Juniors:** Juniors wishing to shoot must shoot as adults. Parents/guardians of junior archers must sign the entry/consent form to signify consent to their child being drug tested if approached. All juniors under the age of 16 must be supervised.
- Trophies:** Upon the return of suitably engraved trophies, WAA will issue a rebate of £5 towards the cost of the engraving.
- Club Teams:** Clubs are encouraged to compete for the Club Championship Trophy. Teams will consist of four archers, representing at least three of the four bow styles (LB/BB/RC/CUL), and must include at least one archer of each sex. Clubs may enter more than one team (e.g. club A/B/C). Team members must be identified before shooting commences (names to be finalised when target list is published, but can be identified on the entry form if known).
- GDPR:** When you enter competitions the following information may be collected and shared with tournament organisers, scoring systems, and other competitors. For example, target lists and results may be published: First Name, Surname, Gender, Bow style, Date of Birth / Age category, Email, Address, Phone number, Club (and ID), County (and ID), Region (and ID), Round (unless defined by age), Disabled (Y/N), Disability info.
